"For by grace you have been saved through faith. And this is not your own doing; it is the gift of God." Ephesians 2:8 (English Standard Version)

## Luke 17 - Looking At The Parable

- A. 17:1 - This is a \_\_\_\_\_ (though it's not called that) that was spoken to the \_\_\_\_\_ of Jesus.
- B. The parable in its context:
- 17:1-4 - They are warned not to cause any to \_\_\_\_\_, and to be ready to \_\_\_\_\_ others \_\_\_\_\_ times in a day.
  - 17:5,6 - "\_\_\_\_\_ our faith!" they responded:

### A. *Christ is serious about forgiving others:*

- 17:5 - His apostles felt they didn't have enough \_\_\_\_\_.
