

# John's Gospel: Signs

"This, the first of His signs, Jesus did at Cana in Galilee, and manifested His glory. And His disciples believed in Him." Hebrews 4:16 (ESV)

## The Beginning Of Signs In Jesus' Ministry

A. 2:1-11 - Jesus changes water into wine:

1. 2:3,4 - \_\_\_\_\_ told Jesus there was no \_\_\_\_\_.

A. **Signs have the power to convince:**

B. **Signs continue to have power after they're performed:**
