## 1 Kings 17 - The Faith Of The Widow

- A. Luke 4:25,26 - This \_\_\_\_\_ is worth our consideration because \_\_\_\_\_ mentioned her, though He knew it would cause \_\_\_\_\_.
- B. 1 Kings 17 - The widow of Zarephath:
